Cultural Infrastructure Index

The Cultural Infrastructure Index seeks to measure investment in capital projects in the cultural sector globally, identifying projects with a budget of US\$10 million or more that were announced publicly or completed within a calendar year. "Cultural infrastructure" comprises museums/galleries, performing arts centers, multifunction arts venues, and cultural hubs or districts. Types of projects tracked include new buildings, renovations, expansions, and adaptive reuse.

Introduction



The 2022 Cultural Infrastructure Index is the seventh annual edition published by AEA Consulting.¹ The Index seeks to measure investment in capital projects in the cultural sector globally, identifying projects with a budget of US\$10 million or more that were publicly announced or completed within a calendar year. “Cultural infrastructure” comprises museums/ galleries, performing arts centers, multi-function arts venues, and cultural hubs or districts, and projects tracked include new buildings, renovations, expansions, and adaptive reuse.

The data that underpins the Index is gathered daily throughout the year by AEA’s Laura Casale who

combs through publications in English, Spanish, Russian, Arabic, and Chinese, including aggregator sites and news forums. The Index only captures projects that are announced formally as either planned or completed. Almost all completed projects have been formally announced, but not all planned projects are. For example, we are aware that there are numerous cultural infrastructure projects in the Gulf region that are in an advanced stage of planning but will not be captured in the Index until they are completed. While we cannot claim that the Index is exhaustive, it is intended to provide an accurate picture of trends in global cultural infrastructure investment and offer useful information on the number, type, location, and budgets of major cultural infrastructure projects announced and completed every year. After a decade of tracking we have a high degree of confidence in the picture that we draw.

In 2021, we reported a record number of completed and announced projects following a dip during the global pandemic. In 2022, the number of completed projects dropped 12% to 185, but remained significantly higher than previous years, while the number of announced projects has continued to climb, increasing by 29% to 225. It appears that the volume of investment has more than made up for the Covid lull and investment has returned to pre-pandemic levels, some \$15.1 billion in total. Taking a long-term view, it appears that we may be yet to experience peak cultural infrastructure investment: on average, completed and announced projects have increased by 11% and 9% respectively each year (2016-22 CAGR).

In summary, our analysis of global cultural infrastructure development finds that:

- 185 major capital infrastructure projects were completed in 2022, representing investment of \$7.8 billion. Whilst this marks a decline in both

the volume and value of completed projects when compared to the record year seen in 2021, it is still the second highest number of projects completed annually since we started tracking in 2016. Looking at the long-term trend, the volume of completed infrastructure is increasing at an average rate of 11% annually (2016-22 CAGR), while the value of investment remains consistent with 2016, representing a reduction in real terms.

- For the second consecutive year, we have tracked a record number of announced cultural infrastructure projects, increasing by almost a third from 174 in 2021 to 225 in 2022. The value of announced capital investment also increased, up 13% from \$6.5 billion to \$7.3 billion. Looking at the long-term trend, the number of announced projects is increasing at an average rate of 9% annually (2016-22 CAGR) while the value of investment remains consistent with 2016, representing a reduction in real terms.

- Museums and galleries remained the most common form of investment for the seventh consecutive year, accounting for 207 announced and completed projects (51% of total) valued at \$7.2 billion. For the first time, multifunction arts venues (84 projects, 21% total) were a more popular construction than performing arts centers (81 projects, 20% total) and show signs of future growth – the number of announced multifunction venues was up by 52%. Nonetheless, multifunctional spaces account for significantly less capital investment due to the specialized requirements associated with the performing arts: the median budget for a completed multifunctional venue was \$21 million compared with \$42 million for a performing arts center. Cultural districts remain a minority of total project volume and value (both 9%), but also show signs of growth – this year, the number of announced projects increased by 42% to 27.
- Geographically, North America continues to have the largest share of completed infrastructure (63 projects, 34% of total), although Europe (49 projects, 26% total) and Asia (44 projects, 24% total) were not far behind. 12 projects were completed in Australia/New Zealand (6% total) representing \$927 million of investment,

significantly higher than previous years as major projects such as the Walsh Bay Arts Precinct in Sydney (\$249 million) and the Art Gallery of New South Wales Sydney Modern (\$231 million) opened their doors. The Middle East, Latin America, and Africa accounted for 17 completed projects (9% total). The number of announced projects show a similar distribution and increased in all territories except Africa and Latin America.

- While the majority of investment can be traced to a handful of countries – Australia, China, the UK and the US account for \$10 billion investment (66% total) – there is notable growth visible elsewhere. In India, for example, recorded investment more than tripled from \$51 million to \$235 million. Moreover, the development of infrastructure outside of traditional urban cultural centers is on the rise. In total, projects were recorded in 54 countries and over 300 towns and cities, only 28% of which are among the top 75 global urban centers.²
- As in previous years, the majority of projects recorded were either not-for-profit (44%) or

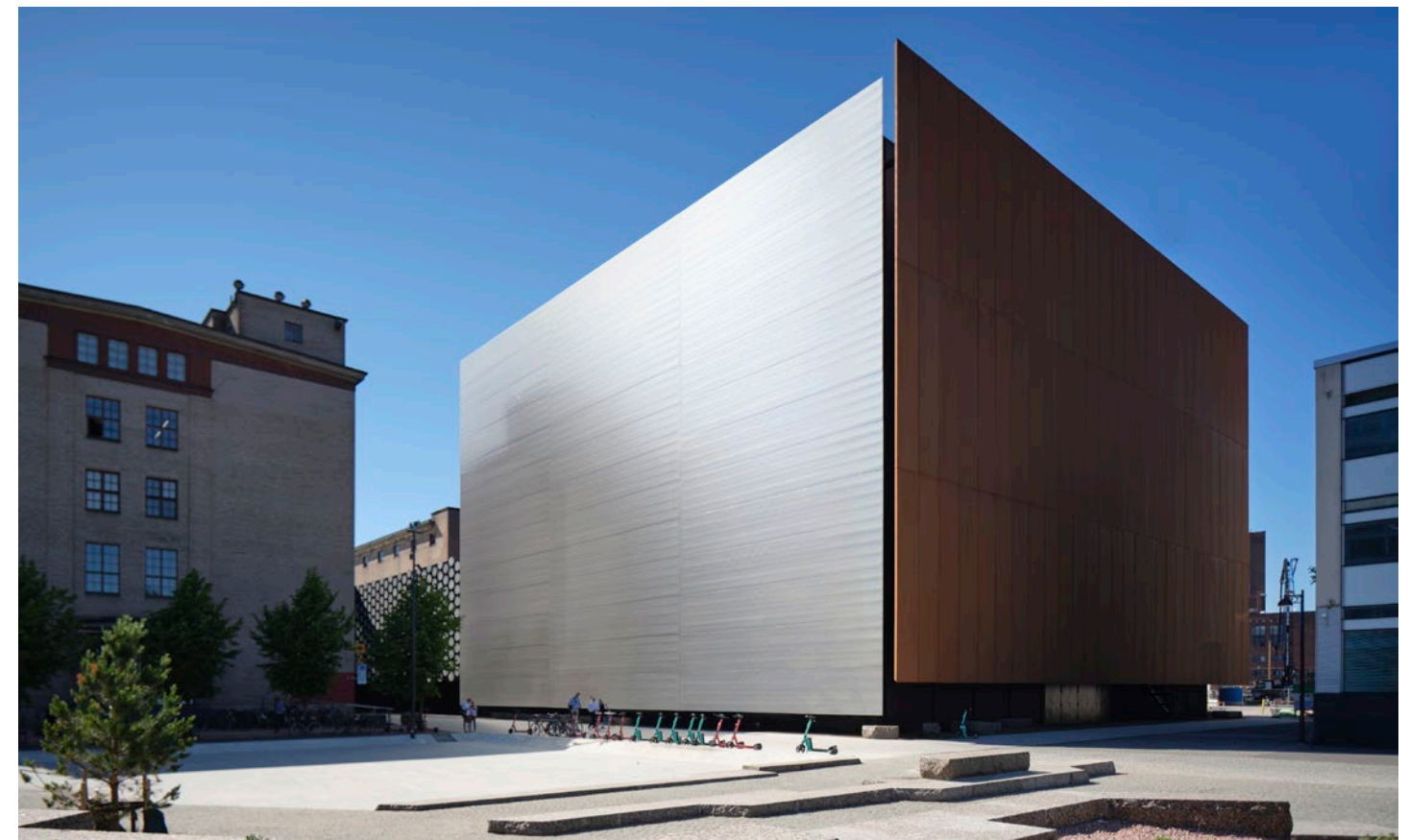
public sector (36%), representing \$14.3 billion of investment in completed and announced projects. While accounting for only a small proportion (6%) of the total, the number of privately funded projects almost doubled – perhaps an indicator of increased private sector confidence following the waning of the pandemic. The volume and value of other private and public/ private projects both declined, together representing less than 1% of capital investment.

- The majority of completed projects were new build (103 projects, 56% of total); adaptive reuse projects (37 projects, 20% total); and renovations (35 projects, 19% total). This is the second year that we have included adaptive reuse as a construction category, but it already accounts for almost a fifth (19%) of projects. Expansions to existing infrastructure on the other hand represent only a small minority of projects (10 projects, 5% total).
- The most frequently engaged architectural practices in the 2022 Index were Beyer Blinder Belle, Kengo Kuma and Associates, and Snøhetta,

leading four projects each. Ennead Architects and OMA were also busy this year, each responsible for three projects. Since 2016, the most frequently engaged practices were Kengo Kuma and Associates (14 projects), David Chipperfield Architects (13 projects), and Herzog & de Meuron (11 projects).

- The top three highest value projects completed in 2022 were: the Dr. Phillips Center for the Performing Arts in Orlando, Florida (\$610 million); the National Museum of Norway in Oslo (\$576 million); and the Lincoln Center David Geffen Hall in New York (\$550 million). The top three announced projects were: Powerhouse Ultimo in Sydney (\$335 million); the National Archaeological Museum in Athens (\$329 million); and Wuxi Symphony Hall (\$326 million).

We look forward to the 2023 Index to continue to monitor these trends.

“All the world’s a stage”: The rise of immersive experiences



Purpose-built venues designed to accommodate immersive and digital experiences are appearing around the world, quickly becoming cultural and entertainment anchors of their respective neighborhoods. Recent examples include Meow Wolf’s interactive supermarket in Las Vegas (a \$40 million project) and Culturespaces’ Fabrique des Lumières in Amsterdam (a \$13 million redevelopment) which presents large-scale digital exhibitions celebrating iconic artists with projections across 17-meter-high walls and an additional 2,800 square meters of exhibition area. A collaboration between Japan and UAE, teamLab Phenomena Abu Dhabi, is a 17,000 square meter center to be completed in 2024 that will provide a nature-themed multi-sensory experiences. Opened in 2023, Lightroom in London is designed as a four-storey high subterranean exhibition volume with a capacity of up to 380 people in promenade and featuring a state-of-the-art sound and projection system enabling artists to transform the space with digital artworks. In May 2022, ABBA Arena opened in London, a purpose-built venue for ABBA’s Voyage virtual concert series. With 3,000 capacity (1,650 seated, 1,350 standing), the venue is designed to allow for 360 degrees immersive production and is equipped with 291 speakers for high quality surround sound. The six-year production and construction of the arena cost \$175 million and has sold over one million tickets as of Spring 2023. The design of a

hexagonal arena allows for it to be taken down and reconstructed in different locations.

What immersive, interactive, and often digital experiences have in common are the characteristics of the spaces that accommodate them. More often than not, they are the products of “adaptive reuse” – refurbished to host immersive and digital experiences. With a focus on fit out and flexibility over grand design, temporary and permanent immersive venues can be found at heritage sites, converted warehouses, former retail units and office buildings, as well as traditional museums and theaters. Many have become permanent sites in city centers.

Immersive cultural experiences sit at the intersection of art, film, theatre, game design and technology, and incorporate curation, detailed physical experience design and innovative technical development. To that end, the characteristics of these spaces are not unlike those of performing arts venues requiring flexible stage and seating arrangements, the latest acoustic, video, and light design technology, and high-speed IT networks and connectivity to deliver the experiences – whether projected into the space or delivered via a headset. To present this to a high standard, such technology requires significant investment, management and maintenance. Digitally-driven experiences will evolve in line with

advances in technology and, as prices drop and the technology becomes more available, so digitally-delivered immersive experiences will become more wide-spread. As both the visitor experience and the art being presented are defined and augmented by digital technology, the movement is towards highly bespoke, interactive, and individualized environments. This presents a challenge to presenters both in terms of the capital and ongoing operating costs, as immersive experiences iterate to keep up with emerging technologies and audience expectations.

For most venues hosting immersive experiences the technology specification is an essential part of the capital brief, including plentiful access to a reliable power supply and a high-speed digital network, as well as sufficient space to present large-scale works without interference from building support structures. Many immersive producers are adept at working with found and meanwhile spaces, but as the form matures, they will seek out permanent sites that support and enable presentation rather than hinder it. At the same time, access to low-code tools and generative AI will reduce the barrier to entry for artists and producers by simplifying, accelerating and reducing the cost of application development and enabling the rapid generation of content based on inputs and prompts. This will make many new works, ideas and audience propositions possible, all of which are likely to both stimulate and challenge the sector.

Business models will need to adapt; the combined cost of flexibly designed venues and the technology required to deliver immersive experiences requires models that can maintain visitor interest and ticket sales to recuperate costs. Interest in immersive from a broad spectrum of commercial brands seeking new routes to connect with audiences will bring opportunities for new forms of creative partnerships. Real estate companies looking to activate and enliven underused spaces can also offer opportunities for collaboration. More traditional and established cultural venues may choose to launch satellite sites which are better suited to delivering immersive experiences than their existing buildings and can serve as spaces to experiment with new modes of audience engagement, including temporary “pop-up” structures for touring and festival experiences.

We look forward to continuing to monitor how the quest for the immersive transforms public and cultural spaces in our cities and, perhaps, propels the development of a new generation of flexible and ‘smart’ cultural venues.

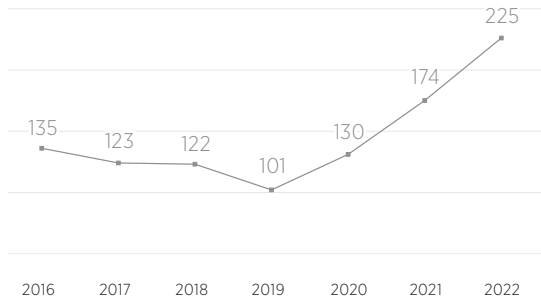

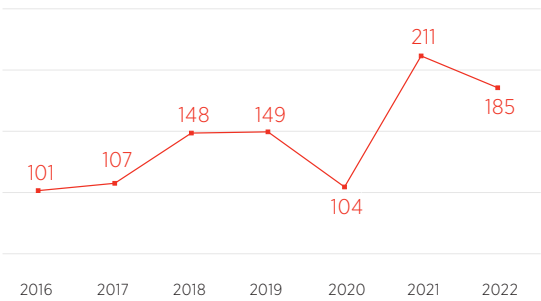

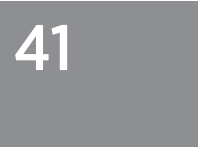

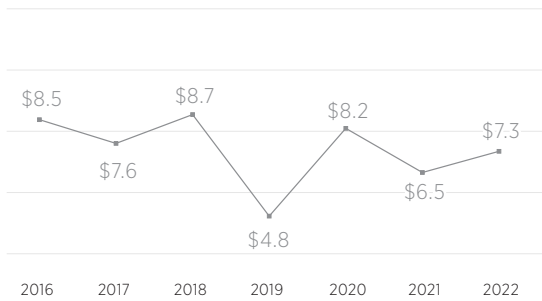

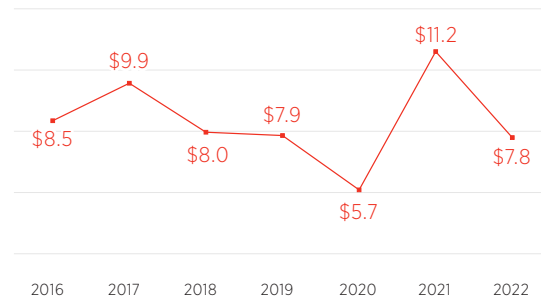

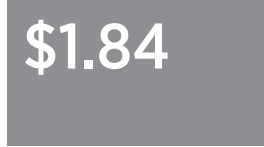

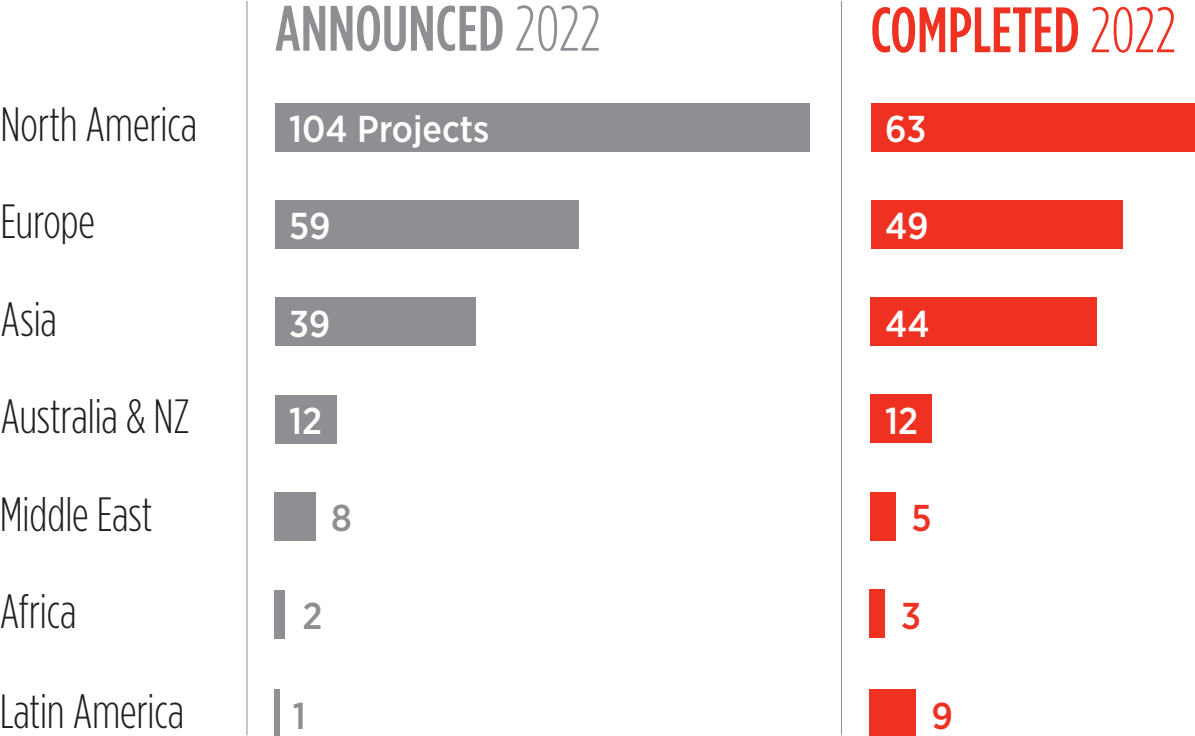

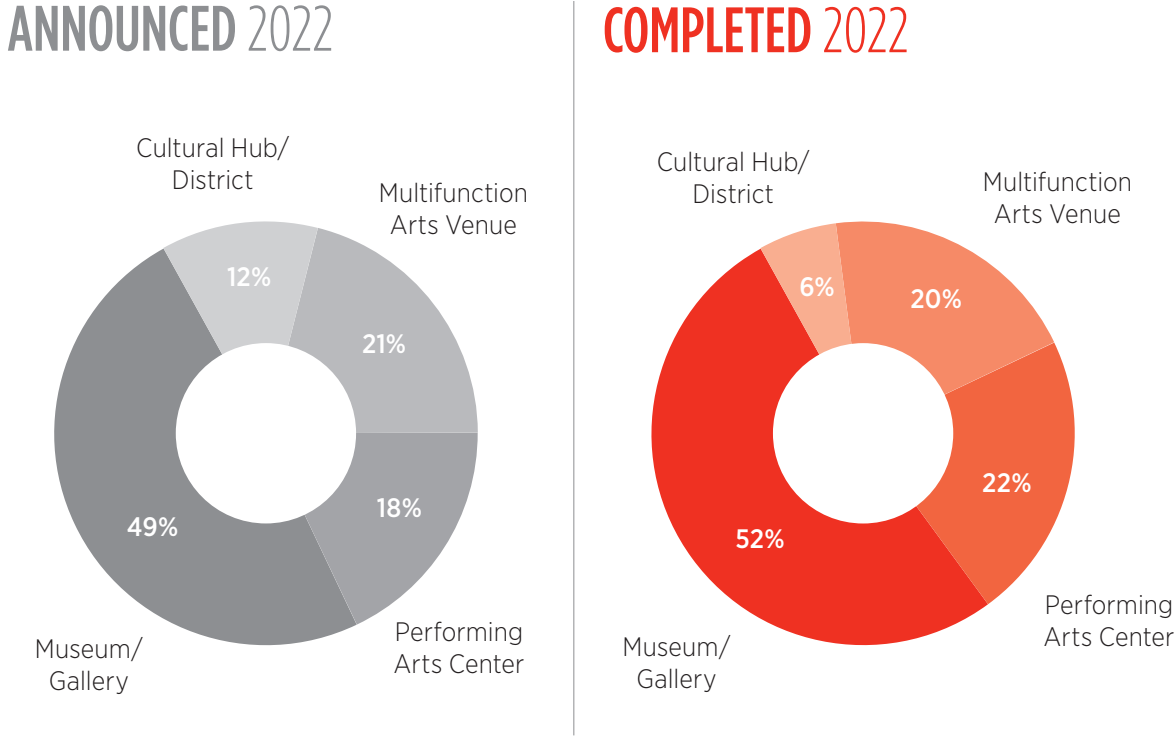

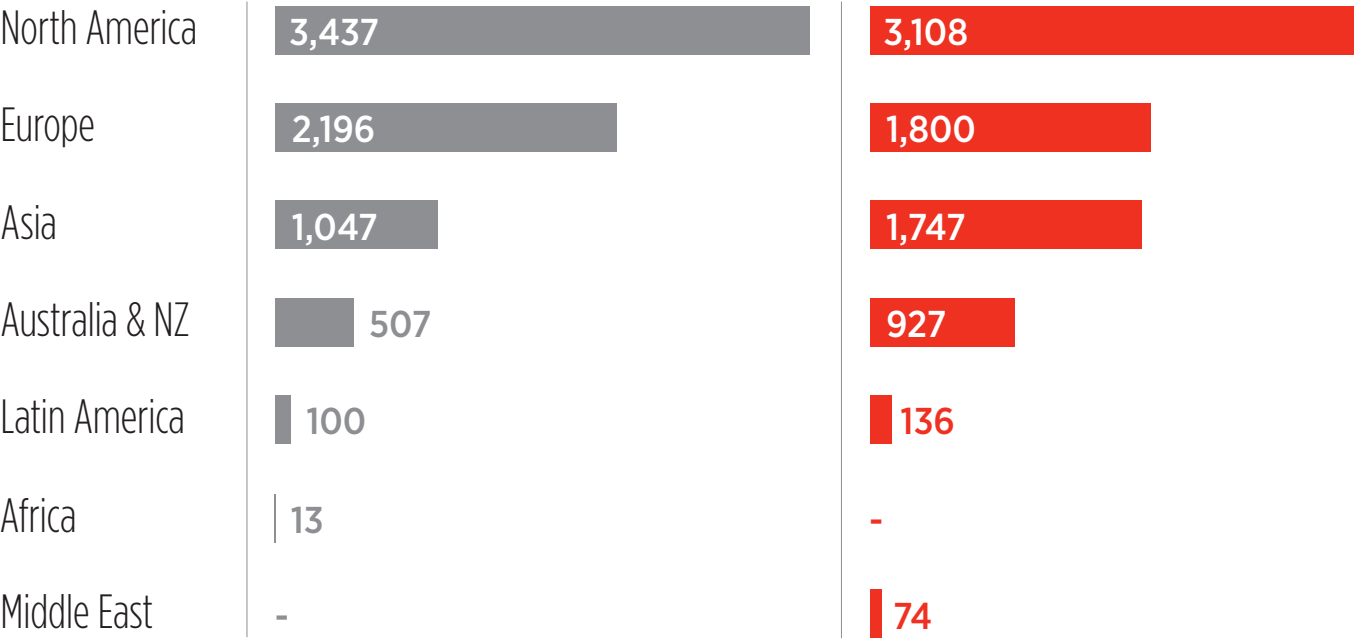
Regional distribution



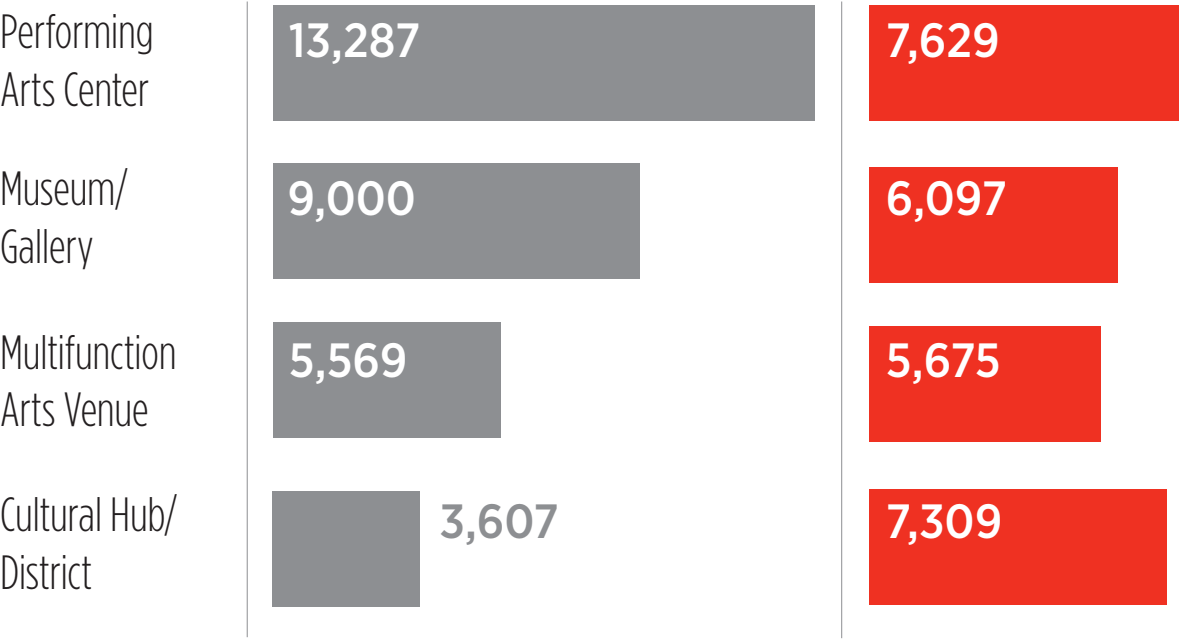
Mix of projects by building type

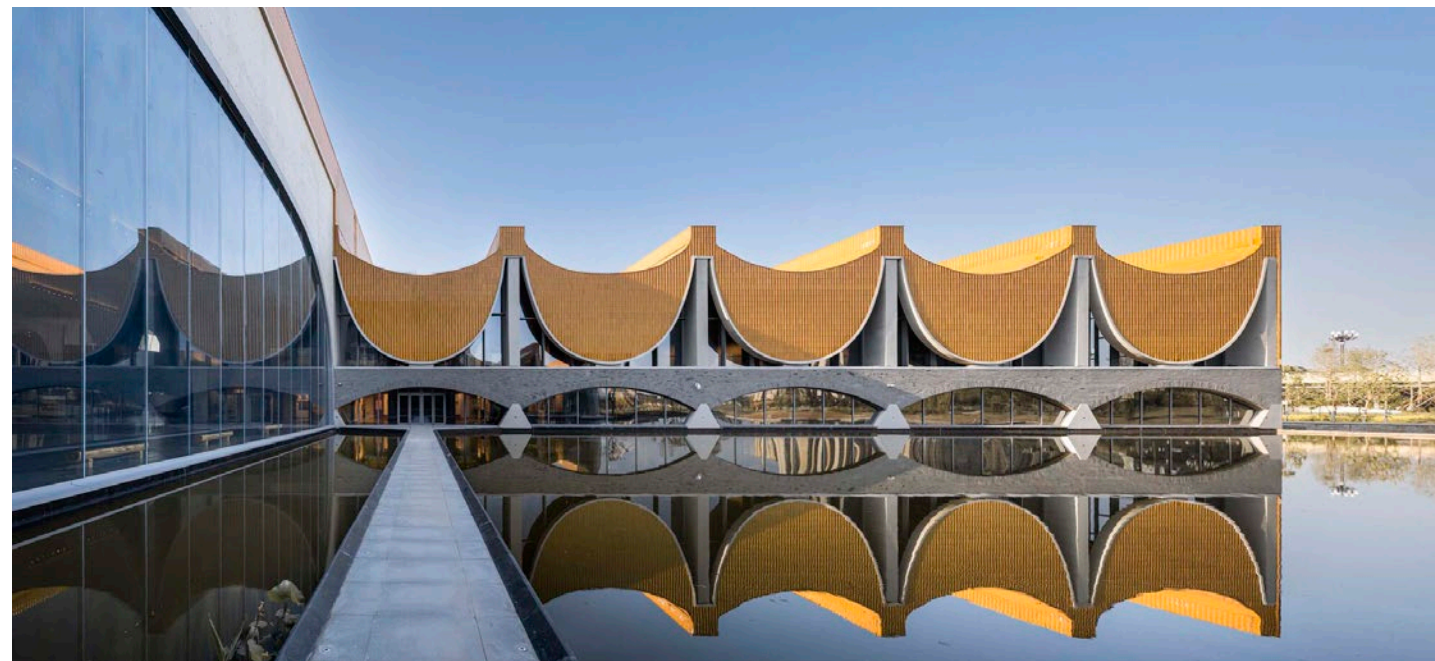
